- Be available during all dates of the entire event
- Be responsible for working with Volunteer Manager to create your own schedule

Specific responsibilities

a. Social media management

Volunteers who apply for must possess the following skills:

• Able to manage internal and external communications within organization

- Familiarity with social media platforms including Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, YouTube and LinkedIn
- Ability to plan internal campaigns and events
- Ability to prepare content for press releases and publications

b. Graphics Designing

Volunteers who apply for graphics design must possess the following skills:

- Skillful on using the Adobe Creative Suite (Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign etc)
- Ability to prepare images for print & web
- Ability to create simple animations
